The Long Beach Unified School District will host six community dialogue meetings this month to solicit public input on educational and facility topics such as school size, grade arrangement, and renovation versus new construction.

During a second series of community dialogues scheduled for February, residents will have a chance to review and rank facility options. This information will be used to help finalize a Facility Master Plan for the school district.
